

# Delray Dunes Dress Code

The Delray Dunes Golf and Country Club dress code contributes to the tradition, decorum, and dignity of our Club and applies to the entire club property from the time of arrival to departure. It is the responsibility of each member to inform family and invited guests about the restrictions contained in the dress code before entering the premises. Doing so will avoid embarrassment for both members and guests. To ensure an enjoyable visit to our Club, we ask that you review and observe the following policies.

## **Unacceptable attire:**

For men and women includes the following: collarless shirts (for men), sleeveless tee shirts, tank tops, halter tops, tube tops or other extreme cut away tops, short shorts, mini-skirts, lycra, cargo pants/shorts with large baggy expandable outside pockets, scrubs, and bicycle shorts.

**Slacks, Shirts, Shorts, Skirts, Suits, or Dresses Made of Denim are not permitted on club grounds at any time.**

## **Golf Course Attire:**

Only shoes designed for golf, such as alternative (soft) spikes or spikeless shoes may be worn on the golf course and practice areas. Flat soled athletic shoes are permitted.

### **Men:**

Men are to wear slacks and shirts with collars or turtlenecks or mock turtlenecks. Shirts must be tucked in on the golf course and all practice facilities. Shorts are permitted on the Golf Course as long as they are no shorter than four inches (4") above the knee. Hats must be worn bill forward at all times and may not be worn in the clubhouse at any time.

### **Women:**

Women may wear slacks, shorts, culottes, Capri pants, or golf skirts. Shorts and skirts may not be shorter than four inches (4") above the knee. Shirts must have sleeves and/ or a collar. Sleeveless tops must have a collar. Turtlenecks or mock turtlenecks are permitted.

## **Clubhouse Attire:**

### **Smart Casual Attire**

- **For men/boys 13 and older** is defined as long pants and collared shirts, tailored tropical shirts (Tommy Bahama) may be worn outside of slacks. Jackets preferred.
- **For women and girls 13 and older**, appropriate dress includes, skirts, dresses, sundresses, pants, and pantsuits or Capri pants, jackets, blouses, and sweaters.

## **Main Dining Room:**

- Golf attire is permitted in the dining room until 4:00pm.
- Smart Casual attire is required in the Dining Room after 4:00pm.

### **The Grille**

- Golf and Smart Casual attire is permitted in the Grille at all times.
- Proper Tennis Attire is permitted until 5:00pm.

### **The Loggia**

- Golf and Smart Casual is permitted at all times.
- Cover ups for poolside dining should cover both the chest and abdominal areas.
- Footwear is required on both the poolside and Loggia dining areas.
- Proper Tennis Attire is permitted on the South Loggia at all times.

### **Tennis Attire**

- Proper tennis attire is required for all Club members and guests using the tennis courts.

#### **Men**

- Men must wear tennis shorts.
- Collared polo style shirts and themed style t shirts are permitted.

#### **Women**

- Women may wear tennis shorts, skirts or dresses.
- Traditional polo style shirts and themed t shirts are acceptable.

- Appropriate smooth soled tennis shoes designated for Har-Tru Courts are required.
- After play on tennis courts, shoes must be cleaned in the shoe bath and brush provided at the court exit prior to entering the Fitness Center, Pool Area, Loggia or clubhouse. Tennis shoes could have clay on them which could damage the Fitness equipment, and floorings.
- No gym shorts, running shorts, or bathing attire permitted on tennis courts.

### **Juniors**

- Junior tennis players seventeen (17) and under taking part in clinics or using the courts are encouraged to wear proper tennis attire

### **Fitness Center**

- Exercise attire is not permitted in any other area of the club.
- Fitness shoes must be worn at all times to prevent injury.
- Black soled shoes not permitted in the Fitness Center.

### **Pool**

- Members, their guests, and their children must wear robes, appropriate cover ups or conventional clothing over their swimming attire when approaching or leaving the pool area.
- Footwear is required on both the poolside and Loggia dining areas.

The staff has been instructed to and will strictly enforce this dress code. The Board of Directors has authorized management staff to ask any Member/Guest to leave club premises should they be in violation of the Dress Code.
